# God Made the Moon and Stars

Genesis 1:16

### LESSON SUPPLIES

- Teaching Picture—Moon and Stars
- Suggested Bible Object—toy moon and star
- moon and star decorations
- baby doll and blanket
- bubbles

### GENERAL SUPPLIES

- Big Bible box
- worship music and player
- blanket, snack, and cups
- stickers and attendance chart

## Spark!

### Welcome

Greet each child by name. To create a warm, welcoming atmosphere, play worship music in the background.

### Come and See

Lead the children around the room. Point out your moon and star decorations (use fishing line to hang stars and a moon from the ceiling, etc.).

### Free Play

Give the children time to play and to become comfortable with their surroundings. Make sure every child has something to do. Help each child place a sticker on the attendance chart (available at [DiscipleLand.com/downloads](http://DiscipleLand.com/downloads)).

### Snack Time

To create a defined gathering area, place a blanket on the floor. As the children sit down on the blanket, give each one a plastic cup with a small snack inside. Children should remain seated while they eat. When they are almost finished eating, they will be ready for *Bible Time*.

## Explore!

### Bible Time

While the children are still seated, bring out the Big Bible. Begin singing (to the tune of *The B-i-b-l-e*):

*The Bible is for me.*

*The Bible is for me.*

*I stand alone on the Word of God.*

*The Bible is for me!*

As you conclude, have everyone say, "Me!"

Open the Big Bible and show the Teaching Picture of the moon and stars. Say, **See what God made? God made the moon and stars!**

Begin singing (to the tune of *The Farmer in the Dell*):

*God made the moon and stars.*

*God made the moon and stars.*

*I'm so happy, very happy,*

*God made the moon and stars.*

**God said, "The moon and stars are good." Say, "Good!"**

Take the toy moon from the Big Bible. **God made the moon.** Take out the star. **God made the star.** Take your baby doll and cradle and rock it in your arm. Hold up a star. **Night, night baby. It's time to sleep.** Put a blanket on the doll. Hold up the moon. **Night, night baby. It's time to sleep. The stars are out. The moon is out. It's time to sleep.** Sing a lullaby to the baby such as *Twinkle Little Star*. Sing *God Made the Moon and Stars* again.

## Inspire!

### Prayer Time

Lead children in a simple prayer: **Thank You, God, for the moon and stars!**

### Play Time

Blow bubbles for the children. Tell them that the bubbles are going up, up to the stars and moon. Sing *God Made the Moon and Stars* one more time.

**\*Tip!** Tape a picture of a moon or star to the end of a flashlight and let it shine!
