

Thank you for purchasing a Venom Nickel–Metal Hydride (NiMH) battery.

Using NiMH batteries can be hazardous!

Failure to observe any of the following precautions can result in fire, explosion and cause personal injury.

Charging Instructions & Safety Warnings

- ⚠ 1. All Venom NiMH battery packs should be fully charged prior to the first use.
- ⚠ 2. Use only a linear charger with peak detection, which was designed to charge NiMH batteries. DO NOT use a timer charger and never allow batteries to trickle charge. Doing so greatly increases the risk of explosion.
- ⚠ 3. Before and after every use of a NiMH battery, carefully inspect the pack to ensure no physical damage is evident.
- ⚠ 4. Always handle NiMH batteries with extreme care and take all necessary care to avoid battery packs and cells being dinged, dented, punctured, or otherwise damaged.
- ⚠ 5. Keep battery packs out of the reach of children and pets.
- ⚠ 6. Do not disassemble, modify, or attempt any form of repair of a NiMH battery.
- ⚠ 7. Do not allow exposed battery wires to touch each other.
- ⚠ 8. Always disconnect your battery from any device when not in use. All devices continue to draw power even when turned off.
- ⚠ 9. Store your batteries in a cool, dry place. All battery packs should be stored away from any flammable materials in a fireproof, non-conductive container, with the plugs/connectors covered.
- ⚠ 10. Always take precautions to cover the battery plugs/connectors while not in use.
- ⚠ 11. Never leave NiMH battery packs in an automobile. Temperatures within a vehicle can quickly reach unsafe levels.
- ⚠ 12. Always keep a class D chemical fire extinguisher nearby, in case of fire when storing, handling, charging or using NiMH battery packs.

- ⚠ 13. Do not charge any type of battery on or near any flammable materials including in or near your model.
- ⚠ 14. Never charge a NiMH battery that feels hot to the touch. Always allow a battery to cool to ambient temperature before charging.
- ⚠ 15. Never leave batteries unattended while charging. Batteries on charge MUST remain under constant observation so that you may react quickly should any problems arise.
- ⚠ 16. Charge each battery pack individually. Never charge battery packs in series or parallel.
- ⚠ 17. Always check to make sure that your NiMH charger settings match those listed on the battery pack label. Refer to the battery label for the proper cell count and 1C charging amperage setting.
 - To calculate your battery's 1C charge rate, divide the capacity (mAh) by 1000. Example: 3000mAh / 1000 = 3 amps
- ⚠ 18. Make sure the battery connections are connected in the proper polarity.
- ⚠ 19. Battery packs should be properly secured within the vehicle to prevent movement and damage to the battery while in use.
- ⚠ 20. If, during charging, the battery exceeds temperatures of 110 F° / 40C° immediately discontinue charging and isolate the battery pack.
- ⚠ 21. If the internal contents of a NiMH battery comes into contact with your skin, immediately wash the affected area with soap and water. For contact with the eyes, rinse thoroughly with cool water and seek immediate medical attention.

Battery Disposal Instructions & Safety Warnings

- ⚠ 1. Any battery that has been subjected to conditions outside of normal use, shows signs of damage or has been retired from use should be disposed of properly. We recommend transporting these battery packs to an approved disposal facility while observing the applicable safety warnings above.
